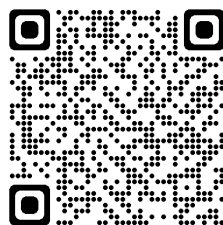


WHERE YOU CAN FIND US

Read Write Now is a community-based volunteer organisation that has been operating in Western Australia since 1977.

Approximately 650 students work with 500 trained volunteer tutors annually to achieve their personal and professional goals. Literacy is a life skill that some adults in our community have missed out on due to interrupted schooling, sickness, leaving the education system at a young age, or due to having a learning disability.

It is never too late to learn and help is available to improve reading, writing, maths, study or basic computer skills.

OUR STUDENTS

The Read Write Now program is for adults aged 18 years and over. Adults from overseas need to be permanent residents with reasonable spoken English.



Adult learners may need help to:

- read a newspaper or fill in forms
- keep up with studies and coursework
- get or keep a job
- use a computer and email
- read to a child and support them at school



Adult learners meet their tutor:

- one-on-one
- in a public venue or online
- for about an hour and a half per week
