Word Frequency Use

If your student knows all the words on these 2 pages, they know the majority of words that they are likely to read. This may be an encouragement to your student. If, in their reading and writing, you find they have difficulty with any of these words, provide activities for your student to practise them: flash cards, games, personal dictionary, look/say/cover/write/check, word searches etc.

*** teach these words in conjunction with the Whole Language Approach and/ or with student's free writing.


